Summit is a curated space for senior leaders to share their experiences and collaborate to solve significant and emerging workplace challenges.

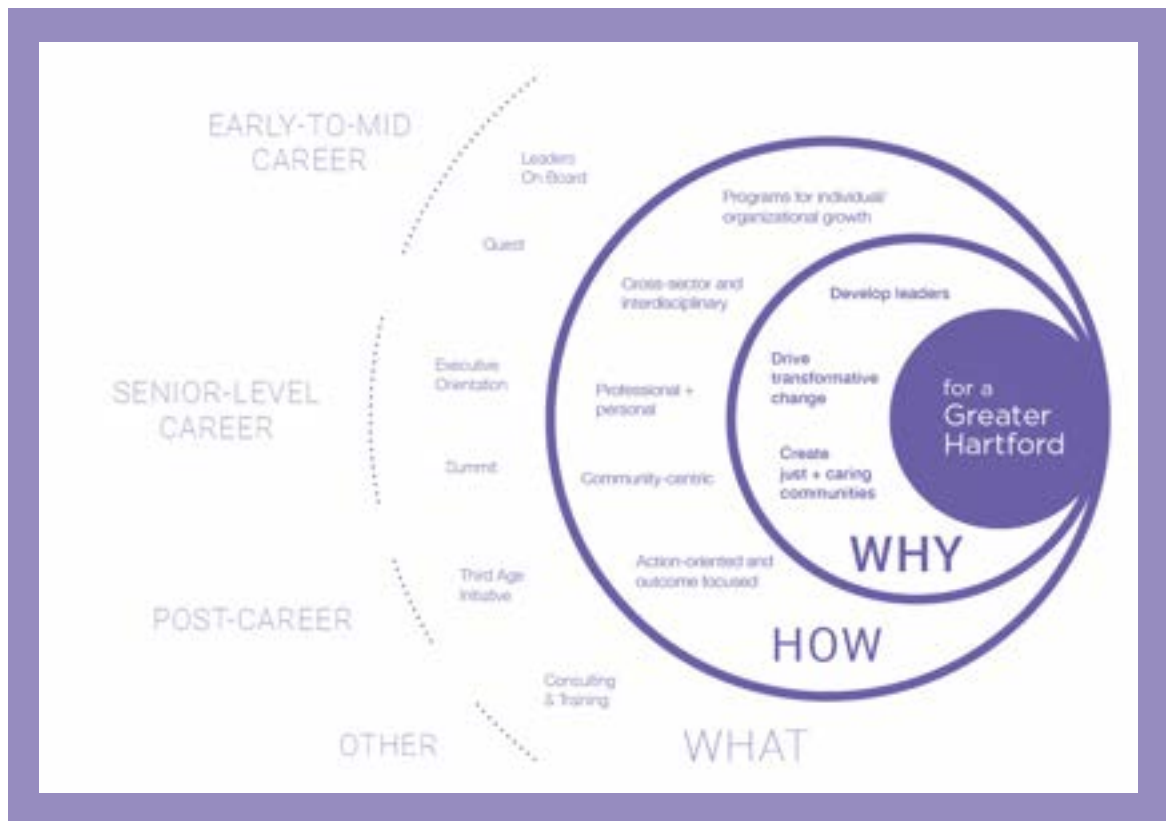

Mental Health – partnered with My People Community Services to help facilitate a mental health youth forum.

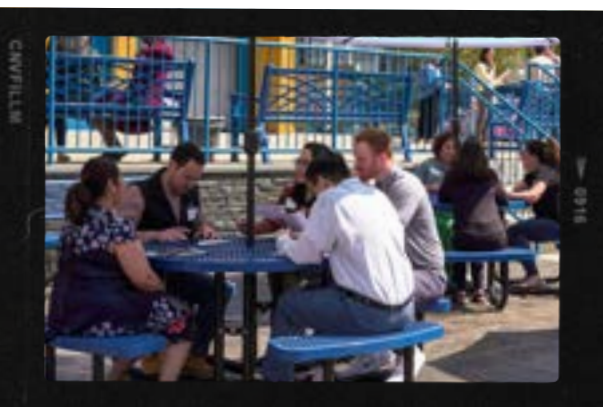
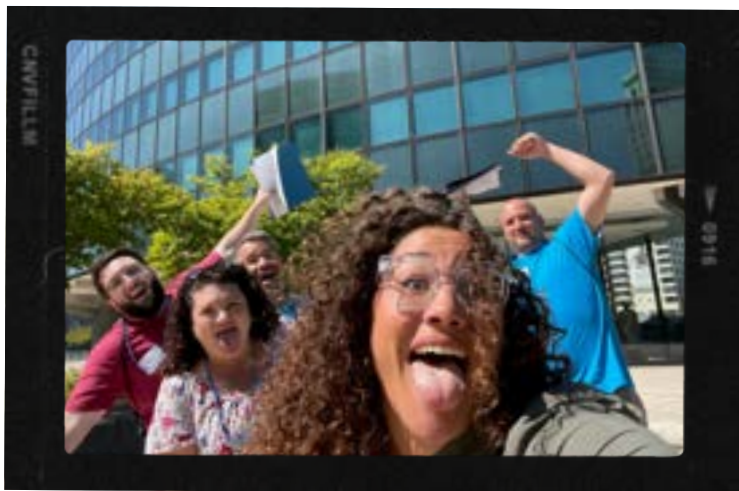
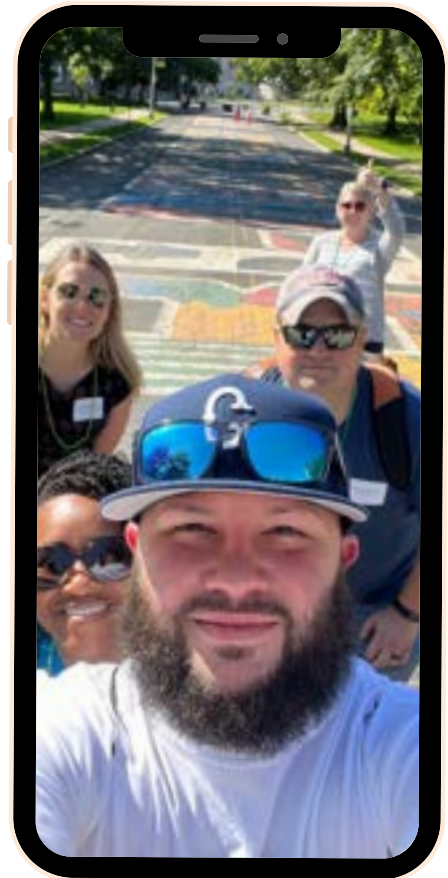
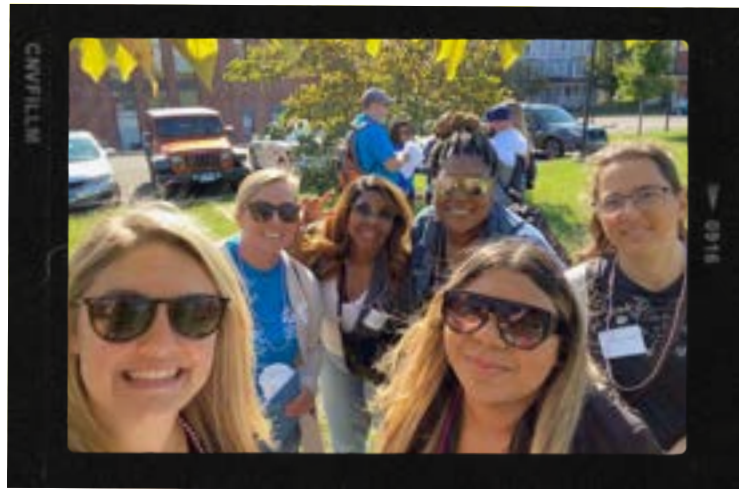

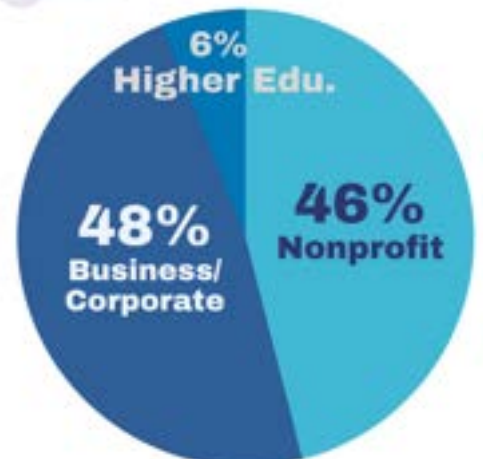
Quest Participant Demographics Over Time

2023 Quest Cohort

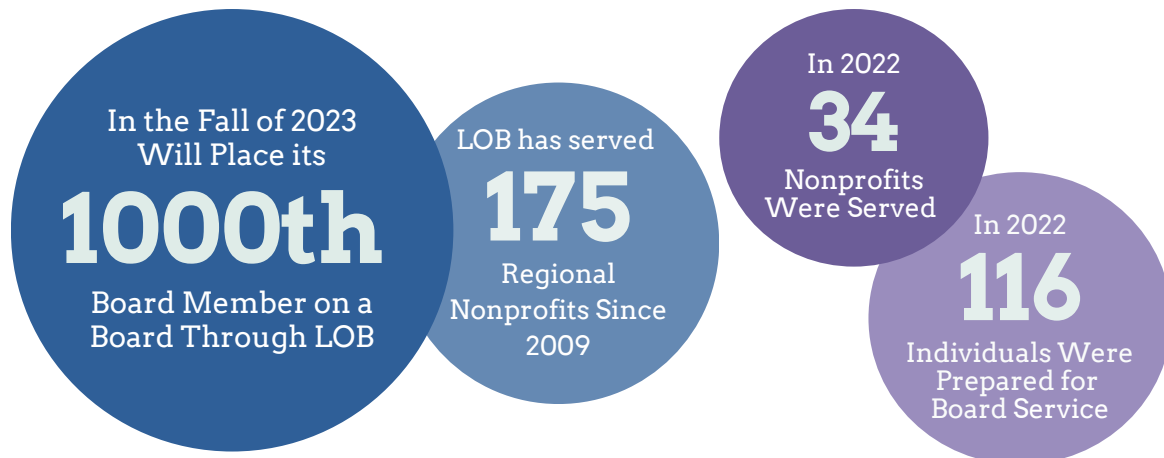


LGH Leaders On Board

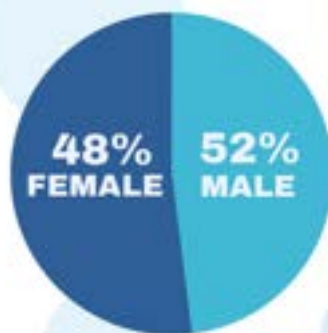

Third Age Initiative Class 16 Community Impact Project Topics

Empowering Youth – partnered with Junior Achievement of Southwest New England to connect with and gather data from JA alumni through interviews and survey research to support the development of alumni outreach activities.

Democracy Caucus – partnered with LGH to produce the 2023 Lessons in Leadership series featuring *I Never Thought of It That Way: How to Have Fearlessly Curious Conversations in Dangerously Divided Times* by Mónica Guzmán as their strategy to address extreme polarization in our country.
