



Summit is a curated space for senior leaders to share their experiences and collaborate to solve significant and emerging workplace challenges.


Third Age Initiative is a year-long program for retirees and older adults that supports the healthy aging and longevity of participants through collaborative, purposeful community engagement.

LGH PROGRAM IMPACT GOALS

Quest helps cross-sector employees develop and deepen their leadership skills by providing dynamic training, immersive community engagement activities, and opportunities for meaningful professional and personal connections.

Leaders On Board helps businesses demonstrate their investments in employee leadership development and local community impact by training employees at all levels in nonprofit governance and empowering individuals to serve as effective board members by connecting them with dynamic nonprofit organizations.

Executive Orientation helps senior leaders who are new to their leadership role or new to the region gain an understanding of the assets and challenges of the Capital City by participating in innovative and experiential community tours and conversations.

Summit helps senior leaders enhance their leadership skills by providing opportunities to engage with cross-sector peers and uses Transformational Change to drive individual goals and objectives for leaders and their teams.

Third Age Initiative helps older adults add meaning to their lives by developing and channeling their talent, experience, and wisdom to enhance the quality of life in their communities.

Consulting & Training helps individuals and organizations grow their leadership capabilities to transform their effectiveness through customizable trainings and workshops.



LGH Quest

Quest is Connecticut's flagship community leadership development program. It is a 10-month program serving high-performing, mid-career professionals across various sectors to help them grow in their careers and our community.

We serve local, high-performing early-to-mid-career professionals.

Quest 2022 Community Impact Project Topics

Food Insecurity – partnered with Forge City Works to develop and implement a survey and conduct interviews with local residents and business owners about their needs, preferences, and priorities for a new local grocery store.

Hartford Neighborhoods – partnered with Hartford NEXT on social media promotions to get residents interested in volunteering with local Neighborhood Revitalization Zones (NRZ).

Minority Owned Businesses – partnered with the Hartford Chamber of Commerce to create an interactive website to help business owners navigate the city's resources.

Mental Health – partnered with My People Community Services to help facilitate a mental health youth forum.







