Our new look is inspired by our desire to center our brand on the leaders we develop. LGH is an organization that helps leaders develop and grow in ways that benefit our local community. We are a place-specific organization that cares deeply about Connecticut's capital region, and about activating and unleashing the leadership potential of our residents, at all stages of life.

With our new branding (thanks to our friends at GO), we can say so much, even in a small space. We have retained our three colors, paying homage to our past while updating to a modernized palette. These colors represent our three pillars of community, leadership, and connections, and they also converge - much in the same way that LGH programs bring folks of all identities and experiences together to develop and learn. The arrow depicts the growth of our leaders, and each letter supports the other - an intentional reference to the importance of connection and servant leadership.

Our new tagline, "Leaders Grow Here," reinforces the local nature of our leadership development work and our new logo has been incorporated into each of our program brands so that every LGH program is always connected to our organization, mission, and vision.

Our long-time home at 30 Laurel Street was sold by United Way of Central and Northeastern Connecticut this summer. Although it was bittersweet to leave our neighborhood, we are so excited to have moved into Connecticut Public's Hartford office in Asylum Hill. We share our new space with many other nonprofit partners who share our commitment to local impact. In our new building, we share space with CPTV, WNPR, CT Mirror, World Affairs Council, Hartford Performs, The CT Museum of Culture and History, and Hartford Land Bank. More tenants are likely to join us soon, and we are thrilled to have such a welcoming and communityoriented new home.





The new business we have launched this year is the Level-Up Leadership Certification Program. Level-Up is a multi-phase leadership development program designed to serve cohorts and teams within larger institutions, municipalities, state agencies, and businesses. It will transform their cultures and help train the next generation of leaders.

We know that companies are struggling with generational transitions in leadership, how to build and sustain company culture in hybrid environments, and how to inclusively support team members as whole humans, with rich lives and responsibilities, both outside of work and within. Level-Up is designed to help organizations address all of these issues and create environments where employees and companies can both thrive.

We are grateful for the training and support provided by the Hartford Foundation for Public Giving to help us build this new business for LGH. Through their Social Enterprise Accelerator program, we've developed a rigorous business plan, and a robust program curriculum that will help transform the client companies we work with, while also providing vital and sustainable financial resources to the rest of LGH. These resources ensure that we can offer scholarships to BIPOC program participants for LGH Quest and LGH Executive Orientation, that the Third Age Initiative[™] can continue to be provided at no cost to participants, and that we can continue to subsidize our small nonprofits and small businesses when they want to enroll employees in our programs, even if they don't have budgeted funding available.
