



2018 HIGHLIGHTS

Thanks to **YOUR** support, this year we:

Graduated a class of 17 Third Age Initiative participants who developed projects to support "Second Chances" in memory of **Maggie Irving**.

Graduated 49 from **Quest** and supported them in the design and implementation of five community service projects.

Engaged 38 business and community leaders, most new to the area, through two classes of the **Executive Orientation Program**.

Served 13 senior level leaders through **Summit** and inspired them to identify ways they can work together to bring about positive community change.

Trained 126 individuals for nonprofit board service through **Leaders on Board** and helped place **79 of them**, 32% from minority backgrounds, with 33 nonprofit groups.

Through **Common Ground** and **Summer Nexus**, connected a diverse group of **44 students** from **19 area high schools** and engaged them in community service projects.

Strengthened the mentoring component of Leading Off Campus in which LGH alumni provided opportunities and guidance to 18 local college student leaders.

Engaged 150 participants in two Wake Up! Leadership breakfast forums, one that encouraged "conscious capitalism" and another that explored how best to achieve greater "leadership equity" in our workplaces.

Served nearly 2000 people through more than 60 consulting and training engagements with 47 organizations, including taking a lead role with the management of Encore! Hartford, collaborating with ConnectiCare on an innovative partnership, launching a partnership with CT Main Street to incentivize its members to participate in LGH trainings, and facilitating a statewide planning process to eliminate new HIV infections for the CT Department of Public Health.
